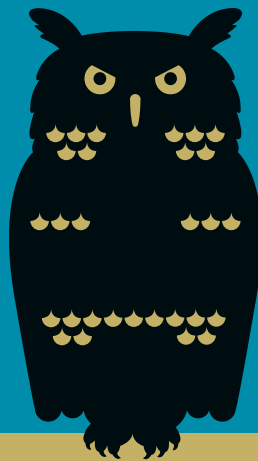


'Skeweringly accurate'

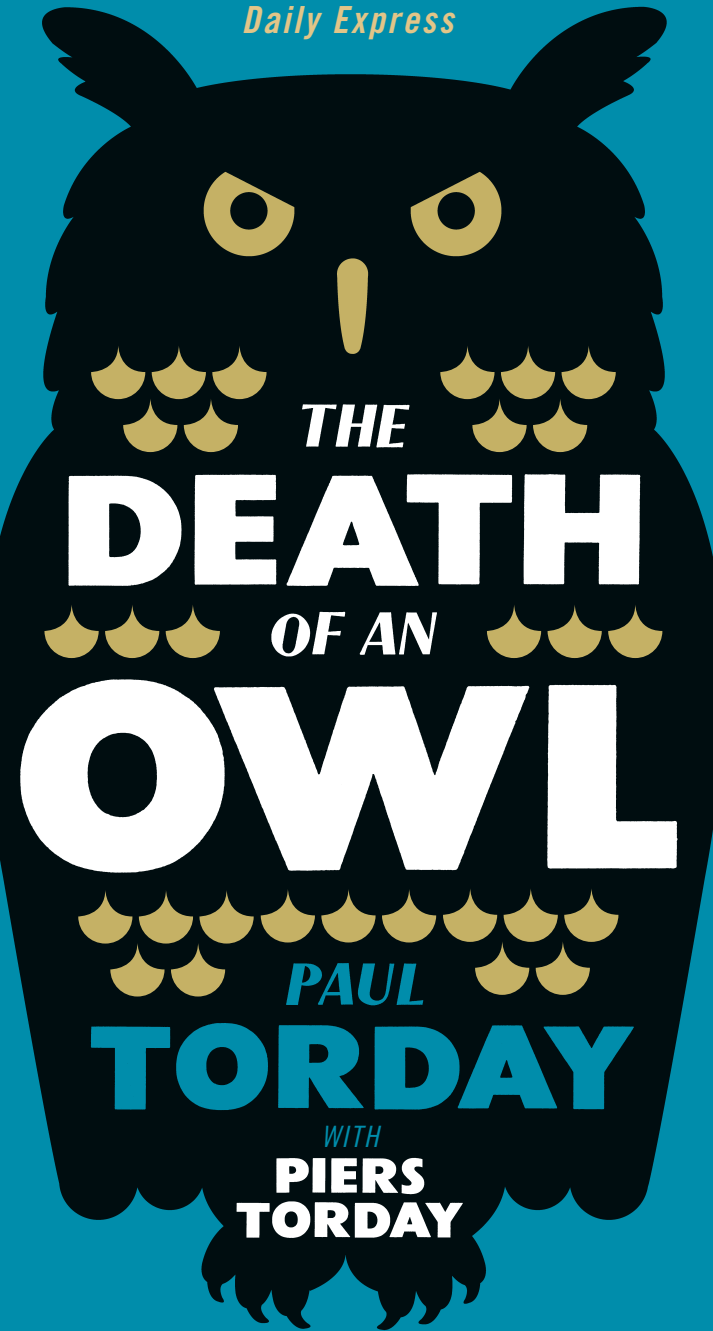
